#include libexplain/close.h>
void explain_close_or_die(int fildes);

DESCRIPTION

The **explain_close_or_die** function is used to call the *close*(2) system call. On failure an explanation will be printed to *stderr*, obtained from *explain_close*(3), and then the process terminates by calling <code>exit(EXIT_FAILURE)</code>.

This function is intended to be used in a fashion similar to the following example:

```
explain_close_or_die(fildes);
```

fildes The fildes, exactly as to be passed to the close(2) system call.

Returns: This function only returns on success. On failure, prints an explanation and exits.
