# **DESCRIPTION**

The **explain\_link\_or\_die** function is used to call the link(2) system call. On failure an explanation will be printed to stderr, obtained from  $explain_link(3)$ , and then the process terminates by calling  $exit(EXIT_FAILURE)$ .

This function is intended to be used in a fashion similar to the following example:

```
explain_link_or_die(oldpath, newpath);
```

oldpath The oldpath, exactly as to be passed to the link(2) system call.

newpath The newpath, exactly as to be passed to the link(2) system call.

Returns: This function only returns on success. On failure, prints an explanation and exits.
