DESCRIPTION

The **explain_truncate_or_die** function is used to call the *truncate*(2) system call. On failure an explanation will be printed to *stderr*, obtained from *explain_truncate*(3), and then the process terminates by calling <code>exit(EXIT_FAILURE)</code>.

This function is intended to be used in a fashion similar to the following example:

explain_truncate_or_die(pathname, length);
```

pathname

The pathname, exactly as to be passed to the *truncate*(2) system call.

length The length, exactly as to be passed to the *truncate*(2) system call.

Returns: This function only returns on success. On failure, prints an explanation and exits.
