

NAME

mtext_ins_char – Insert a character into an M–text.

SYNOPSIS

int **mtext_ins_char** (**MText** * *mt*, int *pos*, int *c*, int *n*)

DESCRIPTION

Insert a character into an M–text. The **mtext_ins_char()** function inserts **n** copies of character **c** into M–text **mt** at position **pos**. As a result, **mt** is lengthen by **n**.

RETURN VALUE

If the operation was successful, **mtext_ins()** returns 0. Otherwise, it returns –1 and assigns an error code to the external variable **merror_code**.
