NAME

Monitoring::Livestatus::UNIX – connector with unix sockets

SYNOPSIS

```
use Monitoring::Livestatus;
my $nl = Monitoring::Livestatus::UNIX->new( '/var/lib/livestatus/livestatus.s
my $hosts = $nl->selectall_arrayref("GET hosts");
```

CONSTRUCTOR

new ([ARGS])

Creates an `Monitoring::Livestatus::UNIX` object. `new` takes at least the `socketpath`. Arguments are the same as in `Monitoring::Livestatus`. If the constructor is only passed a single argument, it is assumed to be a the `socket` specification. Use either `socket` OR `server`.

METHODS

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
