

NAME

mtext_set_char – Store a character into an M–text.

SYNOPSIS

int **mtext_set_char** (MText * *mt*, int *pos*, int *c*)

DESCRIPTION

Store a character into an M–text. The **mtext_set_char()** function sets character **c**, which has no text properties, at **pos** in M–text **mt**.

RETURN VALUE

If the operation was successful, **mtext_set_char()** returns 0. Otherwise it returns –1 and assigns an error code to the external variable **merror_code**.
